#### Maths

All children will continue to be taught number

discretely during their 1.1 sessions .

#### Maths topic area: Measurement

**Spring 2:** Chn will be continuing to sort, match, count and measure objects.



# Life skills:

Children will be learning how to correctly brush their teeth and comb their hair.

#### Motor movement:

Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the therapy balls and trampoline!

#### Sensory room:

Every day after lunch, the children will have a relaxation session in the sensory room.

Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy, water, sand and dried foods.

# TACPAC:

This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.


#### **Attention Autism**

# Reading

They will be read to daily by an adult to work on their reading targets.
