#### Maths

All children will continue to be taught number discretely during their 1.1 sessions.



Maths topic area: Time

Children will be learning how to describe a familiar route and begin to describe a sequence of events.

**Life skills:** Children will be learning about road safety as we continue to visit the library every other Friday afternoon.

**Motor movement:** Children will have daily motor movements where they get to use the scooters, trampolines and therapy balls!

**Sensory room:** After lunch, the children will have a relaxation session in the sensory room. Children will have weekly sensory play. This will involve children engaging in messy water, sand and dried foods.

**TACPAC:** This is a sensory communication session using touch and music.

**Attention Autism:** This session aims to develop natural and spontaneous communication. There will be a focus on turn-taking during these sessions.

#### Extra curricular events!

This term the children will take part in three school-wide celebration weeks. During *Take One Picture*, the children will be responding to a painting and making decisions about their own learning. Next, the children will celebrate the Queen's Jubilee with a picnic. They will learn about who the Queen is and where she lives. Lastly, the children will be practising for sports day!
