As a school, our plans are well underway to ensure our children remember this occasion for years to come. During the school day on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June**, children will be learning about different aspects of the Queen's reign, such as the Commonwealth and will be able to come to school dressed in red, white or blue. We will be inviting a number of special guests from our community to share this occasion with us. Throughout the day we are planning various events including a whole school picnic!

### Jubilee Fayre

After school, also on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June**, we shall be hosting a Jubilee Fayre and we hope that you will join us for this event. Friends of Mayespark will be running many stalls including tuck, ice-cream, candy floss, BBQ food and an 'afternoon tea with the Queen' experience!

### Volunteering

Events such as the Jubilee Fayre are unable to happen without volunteers! For this event we need lots of volunteers so if you have any spare time, please consider supporting our school in this way. Many work places release employees to volunteer at charitable events and even match fund money raised. Generally speaking, banks and building societies, insurance companies, supermarkets, utilities providers, phone companies and car manufacturers support such events by releasing employers during work time to volunteer. If you work for any of these companies, why not ask your employer if they will let you attend? There will be a meeting for volunteers on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> June at 9am. We appreciate that not every volunteer will be able to attend due to other commitments but please join us if you can make it. ### Parent Stalls

I am pleased to inform you that we are able to facilitate parent stalls at this event. Ideally, parent stalls will maintain a Jubilee theme however we understand this may not always be possible. **Food stalls will cost £20.** We can offer a maximum of 5 food stalls, only three of which can sell Indian food. **General stalls will cost £10.** To ensure variety, if you would like to run a stall, please indicate on the slip below what you would like to sell. This might be clothes, toys or homemade crafts (similar to the boot sale). Please note that parent stalls are unable to sell drinks, ice-cream or confectionary and unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate any businesses at this event. If you would like to purchase a parent stall, please complete the slip below and return it to the school office with the required fee, all stalls will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.





### Bouncy Castles

We are planning on having bouncy castles at this event. These will be supplied and manned by a reputable company called Go Bonkers. For children in **Years R-6 the cost is £6**, wristbands are available for two different time slots, either 3:30-4:30pm OR 4:30-5:30pm. For children in **Nursery and younger siblings the cost is £5** - they will have two separate bouncy castles appropriate for younger children and their session will be from 3:30-5:30pm. Children in ARCH will be able to purchase wristbands for any of the above sessions, as appropriate. Wristbands will be available in the back playground before and after school **from Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June**. We recommend that wristbands are purchased in advanced as any bought on the day of the event will cost an **additional £1**. Please note that we can only except cash and that wristbands will be distributed to children on the day of the event.

We are really excited to be celebrating our Queen's Jubilee and we trust you will join us in making it a memorable occasion for our school community.
