I would like to thank those of you who have returned slips regarding our residential visit to France. Due to the high level of interest I am very pleased to inform you that we are looking to proceed with this visit.

As a school we appreciate that deciding whether to allow your child to attend any residential trip is a huge decision and recognise that you may have many questions. To facilitate this, you are invited to attend an **online meeting on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November at 4pm**, for which you will be sent a link next week. During this meeting you will receive a presentation about the visit and have the opportunity to ask questions.

## KEY INFORMATION

**Dates:** Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2022

**Cost:** £440 This is inclusive of travel, accommodation, food and activities.

**Payments:** Payments will need to be made in 4 instalments.

£50 non-refundable deposit as soon as possible to secure your child's place

£130 by 15<sup>th</sup> March

£130 by 3<sup>rd</sup> May

£130 by 1<sup>st</sup> July

## Accommodation

We shall be staying in a hotel called Moulin aux Draps. This is owned by Voyager, the company we are booking this visit through. Our experience of their service in previous years has been exemplary and other schools have consistently had very positive experiences. Girls and boys will have separate bedrooms and teachers will of course be sleeping on site too.

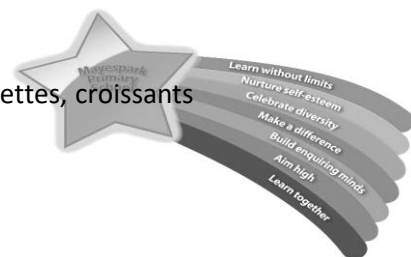
I would like to book a place for my child on the educational visit to France and understand that a non-refundable deposit of £50 is due to be paid via Parentpay before my child's place can be secured.

- a visit to a goats' cheese farm

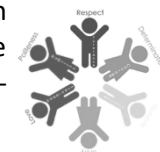


**Other information:**
