
Learning a traditional African call and response song and to recognise simple notation. Composing animal-based call and response rhythms.

Reading the text Fox to explore how characters motives can change in a story. Should the magpie trust the fox? Learning to predict and write monologues in the role of Fox and Magpie. Using what they have learnt about the characters to write their own narrative about what they think will happen next.

Art

To explore artists portrait paintings, looking at the similarities and differences. Using this knowledge to create their own painting. Through comparing the work of different artists e.g. L.S.Lowry, Richard Kimbo, children will develop their own painting technique.

History

Researching the lives of significant individuals such as Rosa Parks, Emily Davison and Malala Yousafzai. Researching how they have contributed to national and international achievements.

RE

Understanding what Christians do at Easter and why this is important to them.


Shapes Games
