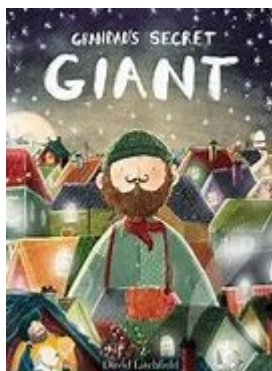

## English

Children will be writing their own version of the story with a focus on morals and acceptance of others. Children will be writing for different purposes, making simple additions, revisions and corrections. Children will learn to use conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and suffixes, ( -ment, -ful)

## Science –Living things and their habitats

Children will compare differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. They will learn about food chains, identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro– habitats.
